

FARTHING PATTERNS CROCHET

1 / 12TH SCALE SQUARE MAT FOR A DOLLS HOUSE



Abbreviations: ch - chain; dc – double crochet; tr - treble crochet; htr - half treble crochet; st – stitch; sl - slip; () and { } - repeat instructions between brackets; sp – space.

American readers please note:

dc = single crochet, tr = double crochet; htr = half double crochet, miss = skip

Materials required: Small amount of No 80 crochet cotton or No 70 Tatting thread, size 0.60 mm crochet hook.

Note: this is worked in rounds.

Round 1: 3 ch [last 2 ch form 1st htr], (1 tr, 2 htr into 3rd ch from hook) three times, 1 tr, 1 htr into same place, sl st into top of 1st htr to join.

Round 2: 2 ch [1st htr], (3 htr into tr, 1 htr into each of next 2 htr) three times, 3 htr into tr, 1 htr into next htr, join with a sl st to top of 1st htr.

Round 3: 3 ch [1st htr, 1 ch], 1 htr into next htr, 1 ch, (1 tr, into next htr, 1 ch, 1 htr, 1 ch into each of next 4 htr) three times, 1 tr into next htr, 1 ch, 1 htr, 1 ch into each of next 2 htr, join with a sl st to top of 1st htr.

Round 4: sl st into 1st ch sp, 1 dc into this same space, 3 ch, 1 dc into next ch sp, (3 ch, 1 dc into next tr, {3 ch, 1 dc into next ch sp} five times) three times, 3 ch, 1 dc into next tr, (3 ch, 1 dc into next ch sp) three times, join with a sl st to top of 1st dc.

Round 5: sl st into 1st ch sp, 3 ch [1st tr], 2 tr into same sp, 5 tr into next ch sp, ({3 tr into next ch sp} five times, 5 tr into next tr) three times, (3 tr into next ch sp) four times, join with a sl st to top of 1st tr. Fasten off and sew in all loose ends, press lightly with a warm iron if required.



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
